2008-09 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL RELEASE CBU SET TO TRAVEL NORTH FOR NCAA DIVISION II ELITE EIGHT

Birmingham, AL—For the fourth consecutive season, a Gulf South Conference Men's Basketball squad will journey North for the NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament.

This year, Christian Brothers University is among seven other squads which will battle for the NCAA Title from March 25-26 and 28 at the MassMutual Center in Springfield, Mass.

CBU advanced to its first-ever Elite Eight thanks to Tuesday's 82-72 win over Florida Southern in the South Regional Finals. The Buccaneers' Elite Eight appearance marks the first time since 1989-92 that the Conference has sent a representative to the final eight for four years in a row (the league sent six straight from 1987-92).

Overall, the GSC has sent 21 teams to the Elite Eight dating back to 1977, compiling a 16-21 (.432) record. Nine squads have advanced to the Final Four and three have battled in the Title Game, led by NCAA Champions North Alabama (1979 and '91) and former member Jacksonville State (1985). The Conference seeks to put the brakes on a seven-game losing skid in the Elite Eight which dates back to 1992.

GSC West Division Champion CBU (25-6) enters uncharted territory for the second year in a row after advancing to its first-ever NCAA post-season in 2008. Christian Brothers, ranked No. 15 in the final NABC Poll, battles Southeast Region Champion Augusta State in the first game of the Quarter-Finals at 12:00 p.m. Eastern. No. 4 ranked ASU owns a 29-4 overall record and returns to the Elite Eight after falling in last year's Championship Game. The game marks the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

The Christian Brothers/Augusta State winner advances to the Semi-Finals, facing the Cal Poly Pomona/Southwest Minnesota State winner on Thursday at 6:00 pm. The Championship Game is slated for 2:30 pm on Saturday, March 28. All four Quarter-Final contests will be shown on the internet at www.ncaa.com. The Semi-Final contests will be televised by CBS College Sports Network, while the Title Game will be broadcast on CBS.

GSC MEN'S BASKETBALL IN NCAA SOUTH REGIONAL RECAPS

QUARTER-FINALS--SATURDAY, MARCH 14

The GSC went 2-1 in the Quarter-Finals of the 2009 NCAA Division II Men's Basketball South Region Tournament at Florida Southern College in Lakeland, FL.

Christian Brothers and **Arkansas Tech** each picked their first-ever NCAA triumphs, moving on to tomorrow's Semi-Finals, while **Valdosta State** lost in its Quarter-Final contest.

CBU tipped off the tournament, upending West Division rival Delta State, 63-54. The Buccaneers extended their seven-point halftime lead to as much as 14 with 6:02 in the second half and never looked back. **Christian Brothers center Nick Kohs** netted a game-high 22 points, while guard Reggie Peyton added 18.

VSU battled Claflin in Game Two in a game highlighted by 12 lead changes, but in the end, the Blazers fell to the Panthers, 54-50. Valdosta State led by one with two minutes left in game, but Claflin closed the game with a 7-2 run, icing the win. **VSU guard Tristan Crawford** led all players with 17 points along with seven rebounds.

ATU defeated Benedict in thrilling fashion in the final game of the day, 63-62. The Wonder Boys led the majority of the game, building a 10-point edge with 10:25 remaining to play, only to see BC cut the deficit to one point at 2:39. Benedict took a one-point lead on a pair of free throws with 19 ticks on the clock, but **ATU center Thiago Cordeiro** hit the go-ahead layup with eight seconds left to play. **Wonder Boys guard Chad Henderson** scored a game-best 18 points, while Cordeiro added 14 points, nine rebounds and four blocks.

The tournament resumes tomorrow when Christian Brothers faces Claflin at 5:00 pm Eastern, followed by Florida Southern and Arkansas Tech at 7:30 pm.

SEMI-FINALS--SUNDAY, MARCH 15

The GSC went 1-1 in the Semi-Finals of the 2009 NCAA Division II Men's Basketball South Regional at Florida Southern College in Lakeland, FL.

No. 2 seed Christian Brothers advanced to its first-ever Regional Final, blowing past No. 3 seed Claflin, 72-53. CBU led from the outset, grabbing a 15-4 edge before the first media time out and leading by as many as 22 points in the second half. **CBU center Nick Kohs** led the way with 26 points and nine rebounds.

GSC Champion Arkansas Tech battled Tournament host Florida Southern in the second game of the day, but homestanding Mocs outlasted the Wonder Boys in overtime, 95-92. ATU led through regulation before FSC stormed back late in the second half, leading by three with eight seconds left in regulation before **Arkansas Tech center Thiago Cordeiro** nailed a three-pointer at the buzzer. ATU held a one-point lead at 2:05 in the extra frame, but the Sunshine State Champions scored five unanswered points enroute to victory. Cordeiro had a game-high 13 rebounds along with 19 points in a losing effort.

The tournament resumes on Tuesday when Christian Brothers and Florida Southern face off at 7:00 pm Eastern. The winner will advance to face the winner of the Southeast Regional at the 2009 Elite Eight in Springfield, Mass.

CHAMPIONSHIP--TUESDAY, MARCH 17

The GSC captured its fourth consecutive NCAA Men's Basketball South Regional Title when Christian Brothers upset No. 1 seed Florida Southern, 82-72.

CBU shot 61.7 percent from the field and held FSC to 25.9 percent from three-point range. **Center Nick Kohs** scored 27 points and had six rebounds, while **guard Reggie Peyton** added 24 points.

Kohs was named Most Outstanding Player, while Peyton and **Arkansas Tech center Thiago Cordeiro** were also named to the All-Tournament Team.

Christian Brothers plays Southeast Region winner Augusta State in the Quarter-finals of the Elite Eight on Wednesday, March 25th.
