## GSC Women's Tournament Recaps

### No Surprises in GSC Women's Quarter-Finals

Birmingham, AL—There were no surprises in Thursday's Quarter-Final action of the 2009 GSC Women's Basketball Tournament at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, MS.

After dropping two contests in yesterday's Opening Round, the East Division went 2-1 in today's action, while the top two West Division squads also advanced.

No. 1 East seed West Georgia rebounded from last year's early exit, tipping off the day with a 67-64 triumph over No. 4 West seed Ouachita Baptist. No. 2 East seed Valdosta State continued the East's winning ways in the second game, upending No. 3 West seed Arkansas Tech, 56-47. No. 2 West seed Arkansas-Monticello advanced to its second straight Semi-Final, breezing past No. 3 East seed North Alabama, 84-69. No. 1 West seed Delta State rounded out the night spoiling No. 5 West seed Harding's upset bid 79-53.

OBU put a scare into the top seeded Wolves, finishing a see-saw first half which resulted in a 35-35 tie. UWG grabbed a six-point lead during the first five minutes, but the Tigers put together a 12-2 run en route to an eight-point edge at 9:18. West Georgia chipped away at the deficit the rest of the way, tying matters heading into the locker room when guard Dominic Cranford laid one in with one second on the clock. UWG sprinted out of the gates in the second frame, taking a 10-point lead at 12:26. Ouachita Baptist did not give up, pulling within five three times during the final four minutes, but the Wolves prevailed down the stretch. Cranford scored a game-high 21 points, while also grabbing eight rebounds. Ashley Huff added double-double, netting 18 points and pulling down a game-best 12 boards.

Defense took center stage in the VSU/ATU contest, as the teams combined for 48 turnovers 31 steals. Neither led by more than eight points in the first half with Valdosta State grabbing a 23-15 lead at 3:37, and hanging on to a six-point edge at the break. The Golden Suns shined bright in the beginning of the second half, going on an 11-2 run and knotting the game at 31 with 14:36 on the clock. The score was tied at 42 at 5:10, but the Lady Blazers took over from there outscoring ATU, 14-2, down the stretch. Guard Michelle Thompson led VSU with 16 points, while Tamika Booker added 11 points, four steals and seven rebounds.

UNA led UAM by four early in the first half, only to see the Cotton Blossoms pull ahead by 15 points at halftime. Arkansas-Monticello ran its lead to 17 at 13:20 in the second stanza, but the Lions did not give up, pulling within three points at 5:42 via a 13-2 run. That would be as close as North Alabama would come, as UAM put together a 19-2 run en route to a 20-point lead at 1:51. Five Cotton Blossoms hit double-figures, led by Monica Perkins-Miller 10 points and 21 rebounds. Erika Brown added 18 points, while Yelitza Rivera added 10 points coming off the bench.

DSU doused the chances of another upset, posting its third win of the season over Division rival HU. The Lady Bisons kept the game close in the first half, scoring the game's first five points and trailing by just three at 7:25 before Lady Statesmen strung together a 12-2 run. The second half was dominated by the defending GSC Champions, who opened a 23-point lead at 7:16. Delta State was red hot from the field, shooting 56.9 percent led by Moe Bell and Veronica Walker who each netted a game-high 19 points. Walker also pulled down 10 points, while Sarita Cooper's 15 assists broke the GSC single-season record (250).

The women resume action with the Semi-Finals on Saturday, March 7th. Leading off the day is West Georgia versus Arkansas-Monticello at 12:30 pm, followed by a Semi-Final rematch versus Delta State and Valdosta State at 2:45 pm. The winners advance to Sunday's Championship Game which will be televised on regional cable by Comcast, CoxSports and MediaCom. Tip off time is set for 12:00 pm.

### Overtime Thrillers Headline GSC Tournament Semi-Finals

Birmingham, AL—West Division rivals Delta State and Arkansas-Monticello will battle for the GSC Women's Basketball Tournament Crown after each squad survived a pair of overtime thrillers.

The Semi-Finals were highlighted by a pair of overtime contests for just the second time in Tournament history (2006).

The first game of the day featured an upset when No. 2 West seed Arkansas-Monticello notched its first-ever Championship Game appearance, outlasting No. 1 East seed West Georgia in overtime, 67-65. The contest was nip-and-tuck the whole way through, led by 11 lead changes and 11 ties. UWG had a 25-23 lead at the break, erasing UAM's nine-point edge at 12:52 thanks to a 14-2 run. The Wolves held on to the lead throughout the second half and seemed to have the game in control, leading by six points with 32 seconds left to play. West Georgia could not seal the victory at the foul line, allowing Arkansas-Monticello to force overtime when Andrea Dubose nailed a three-pointer with three ticks on the clock. Monica Perkins-Miller gave UAM a three-point lead with 1:07 remaining in the extra time, but UWG answered on Dominic Crawford's trey with 36 ticks on the clock. Perkins-Miller responded with the eventual game-winning layup with 16 seconds left. Cotton Blossoms center Erika Brown scored a game-high 22 points, while Perkins-Miller posted a double-double (10 points, 12 rebounds).

No. 1 West seed DSU returned to its fourth straight Title Game, but it wasn't easy, posting a 55-52 come-from-behind overtime triumph over No. 2 East seed Valdosta State. The Lady Statesmen were ice cold from the field, hitting just one field goal in the first six minutes and allowing VSU to take a 13-3 lead. Delta State pulled within one point at the three-minute mark, but the Lady Blazers responded, grabbing a six-point edge at the break. Valdosta State boasted its lead again to 10 points in the middle of the second half, only to see the defending champions knot the score at 50-50 at 1:35 and preserve the score as regulation expired. The schools combined for just one field goal and seven points in the extra frame. Valdosta State's lone bucket came at 3:36 on Erin Kelly's jumper, but Delta State iced the triumph with four straight free throws by Courtney Wilson. Kristen McBride came off the bench to lead all scorers with 14 points, while center Veronica Walker added a double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds).

Tomorrow's Championship Game is set for 12:00 pm Central Time and will be televised live regionally on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast, Cox Sports, WHCQ-TV and MediaCom. The matchup is the third versus Delta State and Arkansas-Monticello this season, both of which were captured by the Lady Statesmen. DSU seeks its 16 Title, while UAM seeks its first-ever
