## 2009 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE SOFTBALL RELEASE

### UAH, VSU Win Regionals; Will Square Off In Super Regional

**Birmingham, AL**— The Gulf South Conference continued to show its softball dominance this past weekend, as conference teams Alabama-Huntsville and Valdosta State advanced to Super Regional play through their respective brackets. They will now square off in a three-game Super Regional May 15-16 at the Charger Softball Complex in Huntsville, Ala.

Alabama-Huntsville, ranked the top seed in the South Region, beat a familiar foe to move on in the postseason tournament. The Chargers dispatched of East Division rival West Florida in the championship matchup, 5-2, finishing the weekend action undefeated. UAH picked up wins against Miles, Rollins and West Florida during that span, coming from behind to capture victories in two of those contests. Alabama-Huntsville is now 49-5 on the year, and currently ranked fifth in the NFCA Poll.

Valdosta State, who hosted its share of the South Regional last weekend, also picked up three victories without being defeated to advance to this point. VSU dispatched of Tampa and Nova Southeastern twice to win the regional and move to 57-6 on the year. The Blazers have now won 16 straight games and had six players named to the All-Tournament team.

This weekend's best-of-three series begins on Friday, May 15, with the two squads facing off in a single game at 3:30 pm. The bracket then moves to Saturday, where the second game will take place at 1 pm. Should there be a third game, it will take place thirty minutes after the completion of the 1 pm game on Saturday.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**EAST DIVISION**

**Alabama-Huntsville** outfielder **Kristina Prater** (Jr., 5-5, Athens, Ala.) is the player of the week in the East. Prater had a huge week, lacing hits and scoring runs as Alabama-Huntsville went 4-0 to clinch the second seed in the East. The junior was 9-for-15, and had at least two hits in every game she played in. Prater scored eight runs while knocking in five of her own. She also connected for a homer and stole a base for the Chargers.

**WEST DIVISION**

**Arkansas-Monticello** first baseman **Kayla Jackson** (Fr., 5-9, Hallsville, Texas) is the West Division award winner for the second straight week. Jackson swung a big stick during Arkansas-Monticello's 12-game week. The freshman had 34 at bats, reaching safely in 17 of them (.500 OBP). She had at least two hits in five contests, including a 5-for-5 performance in a 8-7 win over Henderson State. Jackson had nine RBIs, four doubles and scored two runs for UAM.

### ALABAMA-HUNTSVILLE WINS REGIONAL

The top-seeded Alabama-Huntsville Chargers advanced to the South Super Regional with a 5-2 win over No. 5 seed West Florida in a steady drizzle on Sunday.

In Sunday's championship game, UAH had a huge opportunity to blow the game open in the third inning, loading the bases with a lead-off walk by Kathryn Whitlock and bunt singles by Erin Duke and Kristina Prater. However, the Chargers managed only one run on a sacrifice fly by Kelli Long.

West Florida responded in the top of the fourth inning, scoring a pair of runs to take a 2-1 lead. Catcher Kristee Wheeler led off with a walk. A sacrifice and base-hit later, pinch-runner Stephanie Ryan scored on a fielder's choice. One batter later, UWF pitcher Emily Burge dropped a base-hit into centerfield and designated player Jillian Lafrance beat the throw to the plate, giving the Argonauts a 2-1 lead.

Alabama-Huntsville came right back in the bottom of the inning to reclaim the lead on a three-run homer by Duke. Duke's sixth home run of the season gave UAH a 4-2 lead.

In the fifth inning, the Chargers added some insurance on an RBI single by tournament Most Outstanding Player Whitney Hawkins. Hawkins allowed only one more hit and Division II saves record holder Alex Lewis came in to shut UWF down the rest of the way.

Hawkins (17-0) pitched 5 1/3 innings, allowed two runs on five hits, struck out five and walked one. Lewis closed out the last 2/3 innings to earn her 15th save of the season.

Burge was the losing pitcher for UWF. The senior pitched 4 1/3 innings, allowed five runs on 10 hits. She struck out three and walked three.

At the plate, four Chargers had two hits apiece. Whitlock was 2-for-2, while Duke and Hawkins were 2-for-3 and Prater 2-for-4. Duke had the homer and three RBI. For West Florida, both Burge and Shannon Miles were 2-for-3. Burge had a double and an RBI.

### VALDOSTA SWEEPS THROUGH REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

Valdosta State beat Nova Southeastern, 5-4, for the opportunity to face Alabama-Huntsville for the NCAA South Region Championship. Six Lady Blazers made the All-Tournament Team with Marti Littlefield being recognized as the Most Outstanding Player. Her game-winning two-run homer helped her win the award.

Nova Southeastern out hit VSU, 10-8, but the Lady Blazers were more efficient. Stephanie Carlson hit a two-run shot in the second inning, and Littlefield's came in the seventh. Carlson's hitting coupled with great defense helped her get named to the All-Tournament Team. April Hutchens also made the team, and was great at the plate for Valdosta State with a two for three day while Brianna Collis went one for two and pitched 3.1 innings. Collis struck out four and allowed one earned run on the day, her only one of the tournament. She was also named to the All-Tournament Team.

Carlson picked up where she left off at the Gulf South Conference Tournament to start the scoring Sunday. After Alyssa Shirey reached first base on a walk, Carlson bombed her first home run of the tournament.

Nova Southeastern responded with a run of its own in the bottom of the second inning. Erica Barrabi reached on an error and made her way around the bases. It was the only run VSU allowed in an inning the Sharks spent most of the time with bases loaded.

In the fourth inning, Collis worked the count for a walk. After that, Becca Aszman singled to left field. Hutchens followed Aszman with a single of her own to left center. The NSU centerfielder tried to make the throw to third, but put it in the dugout. Amber Shaw, running for Collis, scored on the play to make it 3-1 for the Lady Blazers.

Again the Sharks responded to Valdosta State's score with one of their own. Nova's Dana Bergner earned a walk. Katie Pepper entered the game to pinch run for Bergner and scored on a hit by Noemi Luciani. Lauren Lopez tied the game with a solo home run to lead off the bottom of the fifth inning.

The Sharks scored in their third consecutive inning when Luciani came home while Lopez reached on an error. The run put NSU ahead one headed to the top of the seventh inning, 4-3.

In the last inning though, Littlefield's big bat returned. She regained the lead with her two-run homer for VSU, 5-4. Her 102nd and 103rd runs batted in and her 25th homer of the season proved to be the final blow to Nova Southeastern.
